A fruity and slightly spicy aroma, with a fulsome fruity palate which shows The ripeness of the Shiraz balanced by the little edginess from the Malbec.

Aromas of intense ripe fruit, cherries, blackberries, blueberries and fresh plums, Combined with spicy and floral hints.
- 202 Bonarda Reserva, Familia Zuccardi, 2008** 32.50
Full bodied with mild tannins, and lots of black fruit flavours.
Intense aromas of ripe cherries and raspberries.
On the palate it has bright berry fruit with hints of black liquorice, vanilla and toast.

Australia

- 203 Tamar Ridge 'Devils Corner' Pinot Noir, Tasmania, 2008** 27.50
Ripe plum and cherry in abundance, it has a backbone of spice and savoury flavours. Light bodied and silky tannins.
- 204 Geoff Merrill, Pimpala Road Shiraz, South Australia, 2008** 33.00
Blends of blackberries, mulberry, spice and plum with hints of vanilla and roasted almonds. On the palate, dark berry fruits with traces of chocolate.

This is an elegant Bordeaux style of Merlot. Spending 1 year in American oak to Give it a spicy cinnamon character, aromas of stewed plums, chocolate and Blackcurrants lead to an earthy, spicy complexity on the palate.

Fine structure and character. Dominant black fruit flavours with hints of chocolate. Winner of both the Dan Murphy and the Wine society trophies in 2006.
- 216 Geoff Merrill Reserve Shiraz, South Australia, 2003** 62.00
Another fantastic wine from Geoff Merrill, this recently won the great Australian Shiraz Challenge scoring 96/100. Full of spice and intense medium bodied black fruits.

Chile

- 207 Ladera Verde Merlot, Concha y Toro, 2010** 25.50
A lovely plummy Merlot, so typical of Chile. A satisfying wine.
- 208 Compo de Oro Carmenere, Vina Carmen, 2008** 29.50
A nice deep ruby colour, starts with intense aromas of ripe red fruits, rhubarb, Chocolate, and pepper.
- 209 Don Melchor, Cabernet Sauvignon, 2006** 62.50
Espresso and blackcurrants on the nose. In the mouth layers of black fruit, Plush texture with plenty of ripe tannins to hold this big wine together. The finish is long and pure.

France

Bordeaux

- 212 Château Cissac, Haut Medoc, 2006** 49.50
This estate was created in 1899, and through the intervening years it has gained a loyal following around the world from lovers of classic Bordeaux wines. Predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon with 20% Merlot.
- 214 La Reserve de Leoville Barton, St Julien, 2007** 68.50
An unusual find now drinking beautifully. Strong clour with good backbone from A respectable vintage.

Burgundy

- 215 Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Domain Gonon, 2008** 37.95
This burgundy has only had a short time in the barrel so is still light and fresh
- 217 Cote de Nuits Village, Joseph Drouhin, 2007** 44.50
This perfumed Pinot Noir is full flavoured and rich with soft, accessible black cherry And currant flavours.
- 219 Nuits St.George, Domaine Alain Michelot, 2007** 75.00
Ripe fruit characters and big soft tannins, all contributing to a long satisfying finish.

Beaujolais

- 221 Fleurie, Emile Chandesais, 2008** 37.00
Fleshy and aromatic, it has a deep purple colour with an abundance of juicy summer fruits. Strong ripe fruit flavours complimented by gentle tannins and a soft full finish.

Rhone

- 223 Gigondas Reserve, Cecille Chassagne, 2008** 28.95
Aromas of ripe black cherry, earth and spice with sweet oak and herbal nuances. Super soft and velvety on the tongue with sweet fruit spiked with pepper. 70% Grenache, 15% Mourverde, 15% Syrah.
- 224 Crozes Hermitage, Domaine Pradelle, 2008** 38.00
Full flavoured and deeply coloured Crozes Hermitage from pure Syrah. Barrel aged for 9months in half new and half oaked casks.
- 253 Hommage a Jacques, Chateau de Beaucastel, 1999** 225.00
A blend of 60% Mourvedre, 20% Grenache, 10% Syrah, and 10% Counoise. Its inky/black/purple colour is accompanied by a fabulous perfume of licorice, smoke, truffles, tapenade, blackberries, and cassis. Extremely full-bodied, with masses of extract, high tannin, and a structured, long finish, it is a sumptuous effort that should keep for 25-35 years.

Regional

- 225 6Eme Sens Grenache/Merlot/Syrah. Vdp D'OC, Gerrard Bertrand, 2009** 25.00
Medium bodied with a range of fruit flavours.

Italy

- 226 Montepulciano d’Abruzzo, Villa Moncaro, 2009** 26.00
This is a ruby red wine with hints of purple and delicate aromas of cherries.
Although the wine is full bodied and velvety on the palate its not a heavy wine.
- 228 Chianti, Cantine di Montalcino, 2008** 29.50
From the east of Florence at Vinici, the birthplace of Leonardo da Vinci.
This region is lower than the hills of Chianti Classico and consequently the vineyards
Are hotter, so the grapes mature more easily, making ripe, fruity wines.
- 230 LaCrima Di Morro D’Alba, Conti Di Buscareto, 2008** 36.00
A nose of red petals, and small red berries and a taste of fresh peppery fruits
- 229 Rosso di Montalcino, Tenuta Vitanza, 2008** 49.50
Made from 100% Sangiovese grapes and aged for 12 months, of which 6 months are in french
Oak barrels. The bouquet is intense and the wine warm and generous.

New Zealand

- 231 Gimblett Road Merlot, CJ Pask, Hawkes Bay, 2006** 35.00
This award winning winery has produced this soft and rich merlot.
It has plummy flavours, balanced with sweet subtle oak and supported by a fine tannin structure.
- 232 Gimblett Road, Cabernet/ Merlot / Malbec, CJ Pask, Hawkes Bay 2006** 38.50
A classic Bordeaux blend. Blackcurrant, fruit and fine sweet oak aromas
The strength of Cabernet is partnered with supple Merlot and fragrant Malbec.
- 233 Cloudy Bay, Pinot Noir, Marlborough, 2007** 65.00
Typically it has an intensely varietal palate that reveals layers of dark red fruits,
Savoy dried herbs, cherryoak and silky tannins.

South Africa

- 235 Boar’s Kloof, Shiraz Cinsaut, Riebeek Valley, 2009** 27.00
A light bodied and well balanced wine. Dry yet fruity, with a smooth finish
- 234 Porcupine Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon, Boekenhoutskloof, 2009** 35.00
Text book Cabernet, full of blackcurrants, cherries and spices.
All well framed by carefull use of oak.

Spain

- 236** **Vino de la Tierra de Castilla Y Leon, Old Vine Garnacha, Ochavo, Spain, 2008** 25.00
Ripe, soft with beautiful cherry characters, this old vine Grenache is drinking beautifully well at the moment.
- 238** **Marques de Caceres, Rioja Crianza, 2007** 33.00
A subtle wine with flavours of dark red fruits and nuance of vanilla.
It is gently perfumed and has a long, warm ripe finish.
- 239** **Marques de Riscal, Rioja Reserva, 2005** 44.50
Aroma of raisiny fruit with a touch of fresh liqueur is reminiscent of merello cherries.
- 240** **Marques de Caceres, Rioja Reserva, 2004** 45.95
A classic expression of Spanish wine at its best.
Intense bouquet, with notes of raspberries, cherries, and a delicate touch of spice and thyme.
Flavours of black fruits with rounded tannins beautifully enhanced with creamy vanilla oak.

All well framed by careful use of oak

Aromas of black cherries, spice, violet and cola berries.
The flavours are full, soft supple with good intensity of fruit flavours.
