Consultations are available by appointment. All charges must be settled by you with the veterinary hospital directly.



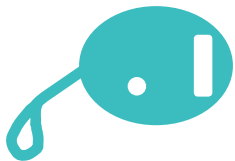

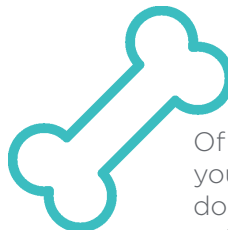
