The Coach House

The Coach House is a unique, self contained building a short walk across the courtyard from the Main House. Encompassing three modern, air-conditioned meetings rooms, the Clarence, Victoria and Concord, it offers privacy and seclusion away from the rest of the hotel while still benefitting from the same high standards of service. All meeting rooms are equipped with a plasma screen, Blu-ray player, MP3 sound dock, modems, wi-fi and electronic black out blinds. Each meeting room leads onto a private walled garden which is also accessible from the spacious conference lounge offering continuous refreshments throughout the day.

The Mowbray and Mandeville Rooms

The Mowbray room is light and airy with exposed oak beams and located on the first floor of the hotel. The adjacent Mandeville room is the perfect setting for refreshment breaks or a smaller breakout area away from the main meeting room.

The Orangery & Conservatory

With its tall arched windows in the style of the eighteenth century, the Orangery offers a wealth of natural daylight and stunning views over the gardens. Its high ceiling and air conditioning ensure it is an ideal space for larger meetings and presentations with retractable screen, projector, full blackout facilities and wi-fi available. The adjoining green oak Conservatory, which opens onto the gardens, offers a relaxing, yet impressive setting for refreshments.



The Tithe Barn and Painted Hall

An unusual and dramatic setting for a larger event, the Tithe Barn offers a high ceiling, natural light and access to a terrace leading into the gardens. The Painted Hall, adjacent to the Barn, may be used for registration, refreshment breaks and informal breakout groups, not to mention a well earned drink from the bar at the end of the day!
